

Understanding Graduation Plans

The Graduation Plan is a student's personalized path to graduation and available from the Quick Links area on the landing page. Access Graduation Plans on demand to review progress toward graduation!



View Progress at a Glance:

Use the **Credit Summary** at the top of the **By Year** view to review progress toward graduation.

- **Credits Required** shows the number of credits that must be attained to graduate.
- **Credits Earned** shows the total credits that have been completed as of the last grading period.
- Credits Needed to Graduate shows the number of credits left to complete before graduation.
- **% Complete** shows total credits earned, as of the last grading period, divided by total credits required.
- NOTE: Credits Earned Not Counted and Credits Needed are for school use only.



Credits by Year:


Use the **By Year** view to see a breakdown of credits earned, in progress, and planned (Not Started) for each year.

- **Earned** credits shows courses that have been completed and count toward the graduation requirements.
- In Progress credits show courses that are currently being taken; credits listed will only be earned after passing the course
- Not Started credits show upcoming courses that you will need to complete.

Understanding the Colors:

Each credit on the plan is color-coded based on the status of that credit, showing either a **Not Started**, **In Progress**, **Completed Passed**, or **Completed Failed** state.



Breaking Down Requirements by Subject:

Use the **By Subject** view to see a breakdown of credits earned and still needed for each subject. Keep in mind that each subject must be fulfilled to satisfy all requirements and earn a diploma.
